**Sub: Consideration of approval of D.Pharm course & exams.**

Sir/Madam

With reference to the subject cited above, I am directed to inform that considering the latest information on record, 76<sup>th</sup> Central Council of the PCI in its meeting held on 20<sup>th</sup> & 21<sup>st</sup> January, 2006 has decided as under-

“(1) In pursuance of the provisions of sub-section (1) of section 12 of the Pharmacy Act, 1948 (8 of 1948), the Pharmacy Council of India declares the **Diploma** course in Pharmacy conducted by institution mentioned below to be an approved course of study for the purpose of admission to an approved examination for **Diploma** in Pharmacy in respect of number of students and academic session as specified here under -

(2) In pursuance of the provisions of sub-section (2) of section 12 of the Pharmacy Act, 1948 (8 of 1948), the Pharmacy Council of India declares the **Diploma** Examination in Pharmacy held by the above mentioned Examining Authority, during the session mentioned above to be an




approved examination for the purpose of qualifying for registration as a pharmacist under the said Act.”

It was noted that besides pharmacy course, Engineering College is also being run in the same premises which is not permissible. Hence, it was decided to instruct the institution to provide separate infrastructure/building exclusively for the pharmacy course at one location which should not be utilized for running other courses. However, it can be a part of infrastructure/building in which a degree pharmacy course is run by the same Institution/Society/Trust.

It was further decided to insist for full compliance of requirements of Education Regulations, 1991 and shortcomings pointed out in Inspection Report and clarify the institution that M.Sc is not qualified to teach under Education Regulations, 1991.

This is for your information and submission of compliance with documentary evidence so as to reach the Council's office within 15 days of issuance of this letter.

Further please find enclosed a blank standard inspection form for submission.
