
The recommendation of the Executive Committee will be placed in the next Central Council meeting of PCI for ratification.

**Other decision**

- It was noted that the teaching staff available in Pharmacy Practice Department is not as prescribed under "Pharm.D. Regulations, 2008" and "Minimum Qualification for Teachers in Pharmacy Institutions Regulations, 2014".
- In view of above, it was decided to write to Vice-Chancellor of the Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore, Karnataka under intimation to Principal to submit compliance particularly with regard to teaching staff as prescribed under "Pharm.D. Regulations, 2008" and "Minimum Qualification for Teachers in Pharmacy Institutions Regulations, 2014" failing which Council shall be constrained to initiate action u/s 13 of the Pharmacy Act for withdrawal of approval.
