Clinical Pharmacist Services & Activities

Drug (Medicine) information: Medicines need effective patient information for many reasons, whether it be spoken or in a patient information leaflet (PIL). Without such information people cannot know which is the right drug for them and, how a drug may be better utilized. It is a routine practice of clinical pharmacist to address the drug related issues (Selection of drugs, dose adjustment, side effects, therapeutic efficacy, contraindications, drug-drug interactions and drug-food interactions) for better patient compliance.

Patient counseling: Patient counseling refers to the process of providing vital information, advice and assistance to help them for their medications and related disease (especially chronic diseases such as Hypertension, Diabetes mellitus etc.) conditions to ensure them to take the medicines properly and manage the disease condition. A clinical pharmacist by providing this service improves the efficacy of drugs with minimal side effects and better management of patients' disease condition

Health screening services: Its individual rights to have the better health and better medical services, it's the fundamental requirement of a community to have the basic health screening services to have the healthy community. ADR Monitoring:
