The event was specifically designed for pharmacy students to enhance their understanding of Intellectual Property Rights (IPRs) and their critical role in the pharmaceutical industry. Dr. SM Biradar, a renowned expert in pharmaceutical sciences and intellectual property, delivered an insightful presentation that highlighted the importance of IPRs in fostering innovation, protecting inventions, and aligning with the global objectives of World Intellectual Property Day.

The seminar commenced with a welcome address by Dr. Gaviraj.E.N, Professor and HoD, who emphasized the relevance of IPR knowledge for aspiring pharmacists in a competitive global market. Dr. SM Biradar's presentation was structured to provide a comprehensive understanding of IPRs while aligning with the spirit of World Intellectual Property Day, which celebrates creativity and innovation. He defined IPRs as legal rights granted to creators for their intellectual creations, such as inventions, artistic works, and brand identities. Dr. Biradar explained that IPRs confer exclusive rights to utilize and commercialize these creations for a specific period. He highlighted the role of the World Trade Organization (WTO) and the Trade-Related Aspects of Intellectual Property Rights (TRIPS) agreement in standardizing IPR protection globally, particularly in pharmaceuticals. Dr. Biradar connected the seminar's theme, *Empowering Ideas*, to the spirit of World Intellectual Property Day, celebrated annually on April 26. He explained that the day, established by the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO), promotes the role of IP in fostering innovation and creativity.












