Introduction:

The one-day seminar on "Artificial Intelligence (AI) and Machine Learning (ML): An Application Perspective in Healthcare and Education Sectors" brought together experts, researchers, and professionals from the fields of AI, ML, healthcare and education to discuss the transformative potential of these technologies. The event aimed to explore the current and future applications of AI and ML in improving healthcare and education. In this context, the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of SSM College of Pharmacy and Research Center, Vijayapura organized one-day National Seminar on "Artificial Intelligence (AI) and Machine Learning (ML): An Application Perspective in Healthcare and Education Sectors" on 11-October 2023. The event aimed to explore the current and future applications of AI and ML in improving healthcare and education and create awareness among them about the NAAC's Revised Accreditation Framework.


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Objectives

This seminar explores and provides a platform for participants to gain knowledge on AI and ML with basics and advanced prospects and to unveil the opportunities and challenges in the area of AI & ML to offer insights to exciting advanced technology with its applicability for effective and efficient teaching-learning process in education and health care sector. The event aimed to explore the current and future applications of AI and ML in improving healthcare and education and create awareness among them about the NAAC's Revised Accreditation Framework.

Executive Summary:

This report summarizes the proceedings and outcomes of the one day national seminar on **"Artificial Intelligence (AI) and Machine Learning (ML): An application prospective in Health care and Education sectors"** held at III Floor Auditorium hall, BLDEA SSM COP on 11-10-2023.

Breakfast and Registration for the seminar started at 9.00 AM followed by the Inaugural Session, Technical Session I, Technical Session II and E-Poster presentation, as per the schedule.

In the seminar, total 281 participants have registered from outside institutes including from other states like Maharashtra, and Telangana. These included Principals, Directors, IQAC Coordinators, faculty members and Research scholar's from 18 colleges; and 76 abstracts were submitted for E-Poster presentation. The program was also live streamed on YouTube .com and about 136 views on live event were observed.

Inaugural Function: The programme started with watering the sapling at Inaugural Ceremony, Dr. BS Hunasagi, Organizing secretary in his welcome address welcomed Dr. Jayaraj sir, Dr. Kotnal sir, Dr. CC Patil acting principal, and all the delegates & participants.. Dr. Jayaraj sir, pro-vice-chancellor, BLDE Deemed to be university, gave a talk on importance and utilization of AI & ML

in current scenario of teaching-learning process. Dr. Kotnal sir gave presidential remark speech. The inauguration concluded with a vote of thanks proposed by Dr. SM Biradar, coordinator of the seminar.

Attendance and Feedback were collected in Offline mode and analyzed. Delegates were involved in both the sessions by the informative discussions by the RP's. For all the delegates Morning breakfast, regular tea breaks and lunch were provided.

Key note addresses:

Technical Session I: Artificial Intelligence (AI) and Machine Learning (ML)

Dr. Anil Kannur, a renowned AI researcher, delivered the opening keynote, highlighting the evolution of AI and its role in revolutionizing healthcare and education. He stressed the importance of data-driven decision-making and personalized learning and healthcare. The speaker, presented on the integration of AI and ML in education. He highlighted adaptive learning systems, personalized tutoring, and AI-driven content recommendation as key innovations in the education sector.

Session II: Online A&A Methodology in Revised Accreditation Framework

The second session started after lunch at 3.00PM. In this session, Dr. Santosh Bhujbal, IQAC Co-ordinator and Vice-Principal, Dr. D.Y. Patil Institute of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Pune made a detailed presentation on **Online A&A Methodology in Revised Accreditation Framework**. He explained minute details of the Assessment & Accreditation (A & A) process beginning with the eligibility criteria to online submission of 'Institutional Information for Quality Assessment (IIQA)'. Next, he described as to how the HEI's applying for A & A process for the first time (Cycle 1 Process) has to register and proceed. He informed that "IIQA User Manual" is available on the dashboard for help. Also, the required documents and the ones to be uploaded were also enlisted. The IIQA Application Process was explained in detail.

Thereafter, the speaker discussed the changes introduced in the Revised Assessment and Accreditation (A&A) Framework in July 2017, representing an explicit paradigm shift making it ICT enabled, objective, robust and transparent. Subsequently, he explained all the seven Criteria to serve as basis for assessment of HEIs in detail. The Key Indicators, including the New Introduced ones, were also explained with suitable examples.

Dr. Bhujbal concluded by saying that each and every data should be supported with verifiable document, therefore utmost care should be taken before submitting the SSR.

Research Presentations: 80+ researchers across the district & country presented their latest findings in E-Poster presentation session, with a focus on applications in healthcare and education. Topics ranged from Pharmaceutical sciences, Health care to AI-driven content recommendation algorithms.
